This Native American Peace Pipe, It was hand made by Black Eagle, a descendant of the Narragansett Indians. Adopted son of Chief Red Dawn of the Santu Sioux Nation. These were often buried with their owner. Has the maker's label attached.



Among the most sacred objects to Native Americans, pipes were used in special ceremonies. The more decorated, the stronger its powers. The pipes were used in important rituals such as the main got peace or war, healing the sick or insuring a successful buffalo hunt. Please note the following item specifics:

MATERIAL:Deer antler, beadwork, trade beads, soldier buttons, feathers and trade cloths.
